- Ability to work independently with little supervision.
- Research and development policies, plans, and manuals for the Museum.
- Research and development educational programming for the museum and apply for funding applications for programming.
- Prepare and deliver curator report to Council and local boards monthly during internship period.
- A valid "G" or "G2" driver license with access to a reliable vehicle. There is no public transportation available.
